




SAVE FUEL: CHECK YOUR HEATING SYSTEM




CHANGE FILTERS YEARLY. CHECK SIZE BEFORE REPLACING.




OIL FAN AND MOTOR BEARINGS WITH 2 OR 3 DROPS AND CHECK FAN BELT.




VACUUM DUST FROM THERMOSTAT.
