

## Stronger Forward Wall of Invaders.

Colgate's Maroon-Jerseyed gridiron warriors put a crimp in Michigan State's hopes for a perfect Homecoming day when they overwhelmed the Spartans with a powerful offensive in the opening two quarters which resulted in a 16-0 victory for the east-erners before the second largest crowd that ever attended a game in the State stadium Colgate scored a touch-down and field goal in the first quarter and a touchdown in the second period, but the Kinke-coached men played the strong invaders to a standstill in the final half and held them scoreless.

State's loss on Saturday was a dis-

State's loss on Saturday was a disappointment to some of the fans probably but to others it was a great satisfaction to see the Green and White eleven put up such a hard fighterainst a team of Colgate's caliber. Colgate according to some reports, has one of the best teams they have had in seven years and put their stronger possible combination into the game against State. The strong forward wall of the Marcons, which averaged around 191 pounds was a decisive fator in the offensive which pushed the winning touchdowns over.
