RECOMMEND MOVE

Committee Asks That Commencement Be Held Week Earlier in June.

Preliminary steps were taken toward one of the largest celebrations in the history of Michigan State college to commemorate the seventy-fifth anniversary of the founding of this institution when tentative plans were made by the faculty committee at a meeting held yesterday afternoon. Many ideas were advanced and discussed, but the only definite action resulting from this first conference of the committee was a move to hold the annual Commencement activities one week earlier so that this celebration might be held in connection with it.

The personnel of the committee appointed by President Robert S. Shaw last week is as follows: R. C. Huston, dean of the applied science division; chairman; L. C. Finmons, research professor in institutional management; J. F. Cox, dean of agriculture; H. B. Dirks, dean of engineering; Miss Marie Dye, dean of home economics; Lewis Richards, director of the Music Institute and H. H. Halladay, secretary of the Board of Agriculture.

The action taken yesterday was in the form of a recommendation to the faculty that "the regular Commencement exercises be changed from June 10 to 20 to the period of June 10 to 13. Also that Spring term examinations be held the week of June 12 at the close of Commencement exercises."

Tentative plans are such that the celebration will be held at a time when it will be possible for members of the undergraduate student body to witness the spectacle. It is expected that many internationally prominent educators will deliver addresses.

Two of the first sub-committees to be appointed, according to Dean Huston, will be the groups on "Invitations" and "Guests."

That the event will attract national interest is certain. Outstanding men and women in the educational field as well as other lines of endeavor will be present. It is believed that invitations will be issued to many prominent dignitaries and that many state and national legal figures will be in attendance.

Mrs. King has been an assistant to her husband in college dramatic work up until the time of her poor health and she had many friends among students and faculty on the campus.

Hinebaugh Announces Plan for
January to June Period.

The schedule of programs for the radio station is now being completed for the period from January to June. Keith Hinebaugh, head of the radio service, said today that he expected to finish the schedule before Christmas vacation.

The program as planned calls for a farm service program at noon daily except Sunday, another hour at 3 o'clock which will include a talk by a member of the home economics department, and other talks by members of different departments which will vary from time to time. This hour will also include some music featuring a trio of students from the music department.

Hinebaugh expects to be able to announce the schedule definitely in about two weeks.

Chicago-bound buses, going via Battle Creek, Kalamazoo, South Bend and Michigan City, leave at 8:30 a.m. and 9 p.m. at the Greyhound line depot, 116 N. Grand Avenue, Lansing. Indian Trails buses for Chicago, traveling the same route, leave at 9:55 a.m. and 10:15 p.m. from the Union Bus Terminal, 115 E. Ionia Street, Lansing. The same line runs a bus to Saginaw and Flint, leaving at 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. These times are also Eastern standard.

Railroad accommodations to Mackinaw City for upper peninsula students leave daily at 4:55 a.m., 7:35 a.m., and 1:10 p.m. However, the last two do not run on Sunday. This via the Michigan Central. The Michigan Central also has trains to Detroit and points east, leaving the Lansing station at 7:30 a.m., 12:30 p.m., and 6:30 p.m. The last named is the only train on Saturday. The Grand Trunk has trains leaving for Chicago at 1:10, 1:55, 3:00, 10:20, and 11:30 in the morning and at 2:30 in the afternoon. All are daily except the 11:30 which does not run Sunday. Student should note that all railroad time is Central standard, as given here.

BACK TO NORMAL

In the current hushes depression circumstances nothing more than a forced return to some item it will have become of the most beneficial process of individual psychology that this country has ever experienced.
