# A New Saint on Boy Governor

To most Michigan State college students Stevens T. Mason is just a name—the man for whom the new men's dormitory was named To a few. Mason is known as the "boy governor" of Michigan But to Michigan residents a century ago he was the 24-year-old governor ago he was the 24-year-old governor of the year-old state, and the center of a violent opposition which followed the financial panic of 1837.






