

## Children of Today Do Own Thinking, Doctor Maude E. Watson Tells East Lansing Child Study Club

Over 200 members and friends of the Child Study club heard an address by Dr. Maude E. Watson, director of the Children's center in Detroit, Tuesday evening in the women's parlors of the Peacock church.

Mrs. C. A. Weber, president of the club, welcomed the guests from several communities in the district, staff members of the new

ly founded Children's Center in Lansing and husbands and guests of the local members.

### INTRODUCES SPEAKER

Mrs. R. M. Bogie, chairman of the program committee, introduced the speaker of the evening, Doctor Watson. In addition to her capacity as director of the Detroit Children's center, Doctor Watson is also a special lecturer at the University of Michigan and Wayne university, a nationally known speaker and a writer on mental hygiene. She chose as her subject, "The Child of Today." Doctor Watson described the present as a time of shifting social standards, fluctuating economic conditions, insecurity and fear of the future and rushing and hurried pace of life in which the business of living together is harder than ever before. This was the background in which our children must live, she stated. She cited "The Citadel" by A. J. Cronin, the plays "What a Life" and "The Wilderness" to show how pressure is brought to bear upon young people to force them into patterns predetermined by adults.

**TO SEE CHANGE**

The next ten years should see a big change in the field of education, if we have teachers in our schools who have had training in mental hygiene and if they are allowed to give training in statesmanship. Education is no longer

a matter of rule and facts, but a matter of emotional attitudes.

Children of today are doing intelligent thinking about world events, stimulated by radio news commentators and movies, and are not willing to have ideas foisted upon them. Parents can help them by seeking to understand themselves as well as the children better, by learning to evaluate their abilities and disabilities and not push them ahead and by freeing them from their own prejudices and anxieties.

### ON VALUE TO MANY

Doctor Watson spoke of her great interest in the new children's center in Lansing and hopes that it will prove its value not only to underprivileged children but to average and gifted children, for the leadership of the future, and for all of us to understand human relationships better.

Mrs. G. L. Ricks, chairman of the music committee, introduced Mrs. F. F. Musselman and Mrs. G. M. Trout, both members of the club, who played a group of two piano numbers, "Troika" by Tchaikovsky, "Russian Dancer" by Rimsky-Korsakoff, and the Brahms "Waltz."

**TEA IS SERVED**

Tea was served at a lace-covered table centered with red tulips. Mrs. C. A. Weber, president, and Mrs. H. D. Reid, past president of the club, now a member of the State Board of the Michigan Child Study association, presided at the table.
