Administration Price Bill senate approved the so-called Bankhead amendment providestablished over farm prices with-out the approval of the Secretary HENDERSON POWERLESS

Final congressional approval of this amendment would have the effect of removing from Hender-son and turning over to Secretary of Agriculture Wickard the final authority for the establishment of farm price ceilings.

This farm loophole was driven into the administration's price-fixing bill after leaders of the farm bloc had greatly increased their strength by modifying their demands. Senator Bankhead of Alabama

Senator Bankhead of Alabama removed from his amendment a provision which would have given the secretary of agriculture au-thority over price ceilings on products processed from farm commodities and limited it strict-ly to farm products.

The concession by the farm bloc greatly narrowed the effects of the amendment since it would permit an indirect control of farm prices by the price administrator through the establishment of ceilsings over products processed from the farm commodities.

Louis charged in again, letting another right fly to the jaw of the Sacramento challenger. Down went-Buddy, but the count of nine saw him struggling upright ready to take more punishment. Louis obliged with a terrific right uppercut and Baer fell flat on the canvas. He had reached his feet again at the count of nine, a heaten figure, when the referee halted the slaughter.

Joe Louis had come through safely in his 20th defense of his title, since winning it form Jimmle Braddock in 1937. He had cleared up neyond a doubt the confusion resulting from his last meeting with Baer, May 23, 1941, at Griffith Stadium in Washington.

At that time Maxie Baer's battling kid brother had knocked the heavyweight champion out of the ring in the first round. But Joe came back to pummel Buddy through to the sixth round. Buddy lost the fight when his Manager Ancil Hoffman refused to let him come out for the seventh round, charging Louis had struck a blow after the bell.

Joe weighed in at 2662; pounds for his return bout with Buddy Baer, the highest he has scaled for a ring session. The glant challenger tipped the bearn at 250 pounds.
