Cost Of Living

THE EVER PRESENT HIGH COST OF living is fast pushing the student's chief worry of marks out of the picture. One solution to the limited budget comes from the University of Kansas. There 188 men and women live in three residence halls, evidently a great deal like MSC's co-op houses.

However, the admittance to one of these residence halls is based on a scholarship system. A scholarship committee judges each application on the basis of need and "future worth to society", a cagey way of saying scholastic grades. Once a student is in, he or she must maintain a creditable scholastic standing to stay there. For renewal of scholarships, freshmen must maintain an average of 1.6. Sophomores must equal a 1.7 standard and juniors a still higher 1.8 average.

The University maintains two residences for women and one for men. The resident students do all their own housework and cooking. The men seem to do well on their own cooking, for reports show only gains in weight.

HOUSE BILLS ARE ASTONISHINGLY low. Last year's monthly average for

the women was from \$21 to \$25 while men's bills ranged from \$22 to \$24. House bills include cost of food, a charge for rent, the student and state taxes, and a share of the housekeeping paychecks.

STUDENT VETERANS AT MSC don't feel that they are the only ones who can't get along on the monthly stipend. A survey conducted among 1,000 co-op vicemen students attending the University of Kentucky and other schools in the area showed a monthly deficit of between \$4 and \$41 beyond the government's stated allowance.

Scientists, Author Win Nobel Prize

Stockholm, Sweden, Nov. 13 (AP)—Nobel prizes in physics and chemistry were awarded tonight to two British scientists while the literature award went to Andre Gide, a French author.

Dr. Edward Appleton, 55, who worked on the groundwork for radar, received the award in physics. He was cited for "his contributions in exploring the ionosphere."

Dr. Robert Robinson, 51, an organic chemist, received the chemistry award "for his research on the structure of organic molecules and the synthesis of new compounds."

Dr. Gide, a 77-year-old newspaper editor, was awarded the literature prize "for his extensive and original literary production, in which he has expressed the profound and sensitive understanding of human nature and the human condition."

For the next three years his enthusiasm for Communism was at a peak, but he became disillusioned when he visited Moscow in 1936 at the time of the "purge" trials.
