WHEN THE UNITED NATIONS VOTED to partition Palestine, it was thought to be the best solution to an ugly situation which has been browing in the Middle East since the first World War. The Arabian people, or their leaders, do not think so. Thus a virtual state of civil war exists in Palestine today.

A recent Arab governmental bulletin amounted in no uncertain terms that this fighting would continue—and in-crease. The truth of the statement is sharply brought out by increasing re-ports of shirmishes and casualty lists

Another interesting point brought out in report is that the Arabs are blaming the S. for the situation as it stands decause Americans gave whole heartest support to the partition plan when it was broached in the U. N. Whether or not this attitude develops into a cry of "capitalistic imperialism" remains to be seen.


