The Allies announced their plan for Trieste in a move to get Italy to go shead with ratification of the European Setume Community. There was a certain cynicism about it, just as there was about the 1968 announcement that the whole territory would eventually go back to Italy, and about the subsequent default on that promise in the light of changed conditions.

When its impact on Yugoalavia was recognized, the Allies began considering a conference to include France which has been helping to support Yugoalavia against the Cominferent. There seems little doubt that this, or some other delaying action, will now have to be adopted.

# Macklin at Night

Most of the activity I've had any interest in at Macklin Stadium has taken place on autumn Saturday afternoons. For that meson, I was remewhat curious early last month to see lights blazing about the stadium's concourses at midnight. Doubting that even Coach Mum would work his boys that late, I ambled over to see what gave.

Well, seighborn, if you think that concerne in cruwled on a nice Satarday p.m., you should see it at the witching hour in early September.

I never saw so many cows, pigs, sheep, chickens, rabbits, and steers in my whole city-bred life.

There were also a few human beings. They were trying to lead absers on cattle trucks to take them to Detroit meat packing houses. The steers apparently had some idea of what was in store for them at the other end of the line, and weren't at all anxious to go along with the plan.

The men handed one way. The steers—each of them convying shant 3,300 hinbbory pounds—handed the other. The men perspired, despite the coel night air. They sweep. They strained. They twisted the steers talls. They got the steers in the trucks.

And then, probably because they welcomed a rest, and because it's lonesome loading steers at midnight, they

answered questions.

The cattle were brought here for the 38th annual 4-H Club Show, they explained. Almost all of Michigan's 83 counties are represented at the show, which is the only state-wide competitive event held on a land-grant college's campus, apart from any state or regional fair;

The show has more than tripled in size since 1942, when it was first held here, they said. It was easy to helieve, leaking at well over 500 dairy cattle, 300 and some sheep, more than 200 pigs, about a hundred steers, 90 pens of poultry, and 36 pens of rabbits (one of which get away; I couldn't eatch him).

There were also more than 150 horses, they said, but I missed them somehow. And 2,000 boys and girls—over in the dorms, with their 4-H leaders.

For four days, they had a great round of home-making, farm, and livestock exhibits, contests, sports, entertainment, and fun in general, the truck-loaders said. Prixes and good prices for their stock really encourage farm youngsters to do a good job, they added.

For the first time since Joe Louis was in his heydey, the SBA left a big blank in the "lagical contender" slot among the heavyweights.


