NARA, Turkey (AP) — Turkish newspapers are up in arms against administration proposals to stiffen Turkey's strict press law, but figure it's a losing fight. An parliamentary commission is studying the proposals.

Moonshine Activities Increase

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Internal Revenue Service said Sunday, its figures indicate moonshiners have been more active this year than last. The number of liquor stills seized has jumped sharply upward compared with 1949.

A service report showed that although the number of stills seized has been climbing, the number of arrests has dwindled.

Through April this year, the service said, 1,253 stills were seized by revenue agents, compared with 1,049 in the comparable period of 1949 and only 864 for the first four months of 1949.

By contrast, in the first four months of 1949, there were 2,038 arrests for illegal alcohol activity. This compared with 886 through April this year and 877 in the first four months of 1955.

Almost all of the stills seized thus far this year were in seven southeastern states. The service reported 1,120 stills seized in Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina and Tennessee out of the total of 1,253 for the entire country.

The Cincinnati Internal Revenue region accounted for 73 still seizures in the states of Indiana, Kentucky, Ohio, Virginia and West Virginia to place second.

Eisenhower Haters' Repudiated

Republican Solon Chides Own Party's 'Saboteurs'

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. Alexander Wiley (R-Wis.) Sunday tagged his Republican opposition in Wisconsin as "saboteurs" of administration foreign policy and "Eisenhower haters."

Without naming names, Wiley said "a handful of unscrupulous and self-appointed king makers" manipulated a state convention endorsement of Rep. Glenn R. Davis (R-Wis.) for the GOP nomination for his seat.

In a speech prepared for the Senate, Wiley predicted Wisconsin Republican voters will "utterly repudiate" these people by re-nominating him in the Sept. 11 primary. Wiley is seeking a fourth six-year term.

PARIS (AP) — A severe newspaper shortage Sunday led the government to limit by decree the number of pages of all French newspapers for three months.

Newspapers, which often printed as many as 18 normal size pages a day, should not exceed 40 pages a week from today on.

10 Persons Die As Panic Grips Swamped Boat

UMATILLA, Fla. (AP) — Eleven persons — none of whom could swim — crowded into a dilapidated 12-foot boat for a joy ride on Lake Orr Saturday. The boat swamped, and 10 of them drowned.

Six of the dead were children. Bobbie Lee Shaz, 20, the survivor, said the boat, equipped with a small outboard motor, shipped water when Willie Foster, 41, the operator, turned it too sharply.

"Everybody got frantic and began to jump out," she said. "Somehow I managed to hang on to the boat."

Two of her children drowned.

Mrs. Shaz said the group took the boat ride to see new homes being built along the bank of the small lake which is 30 miles northwest of Orlando in central Florida.

ALBANY, N.Y.—(UPI)—The St. Lawrence Seaway was dedicated as a "work of peace and a military blessing" Sunday at the dedication of Dwight D. Eisenhower Lock, the first of two huge locks of the United States section of the waterway.

George H. Beckwith, Army Secretary of the Army, said the seaway would provide an artery of East-West waterborne commerce which in time, he was assured, would be submarine attack.

Sen. Alexander Wiley, R-Wis., expressed hope that the seaway would remind the leaders of the Kremlin that it is Dwight D. Eisenhower's lock and not their柏林的 hope that on the seaway, as on the world, more important to develop their country for the benefit of all mankind.

Referring to the recent designation of V. M. Molotov as Russian Foreign Minister, Wiley commented: "Perhaps a somewhat brighter day in East-West relations may be ahead."
