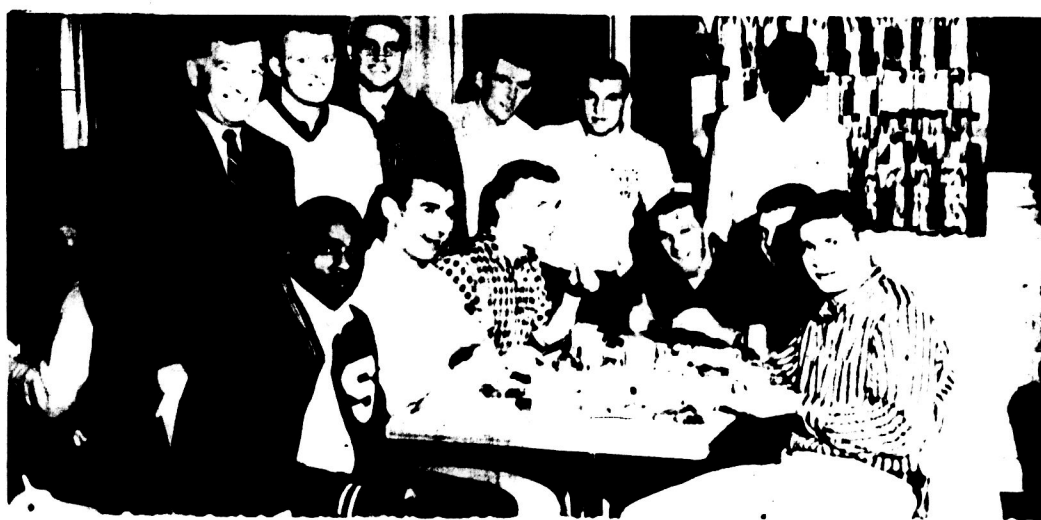

And therein lies the tale. Never in the history of the league's two divisions has a team been able to travel to the east and beat both the Rams and 49ers.

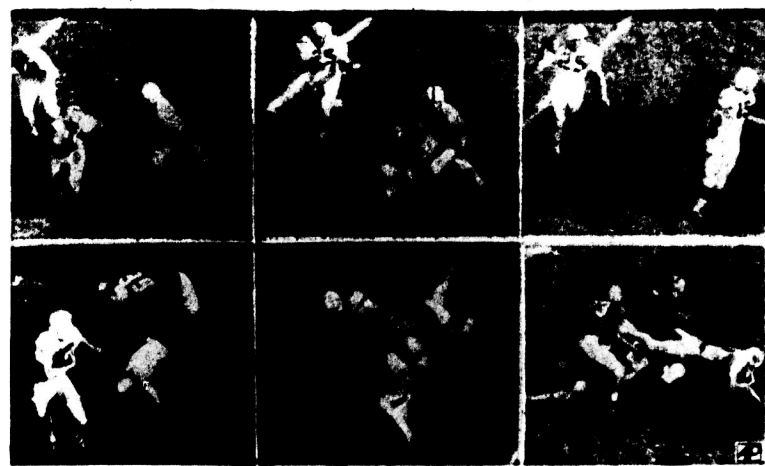

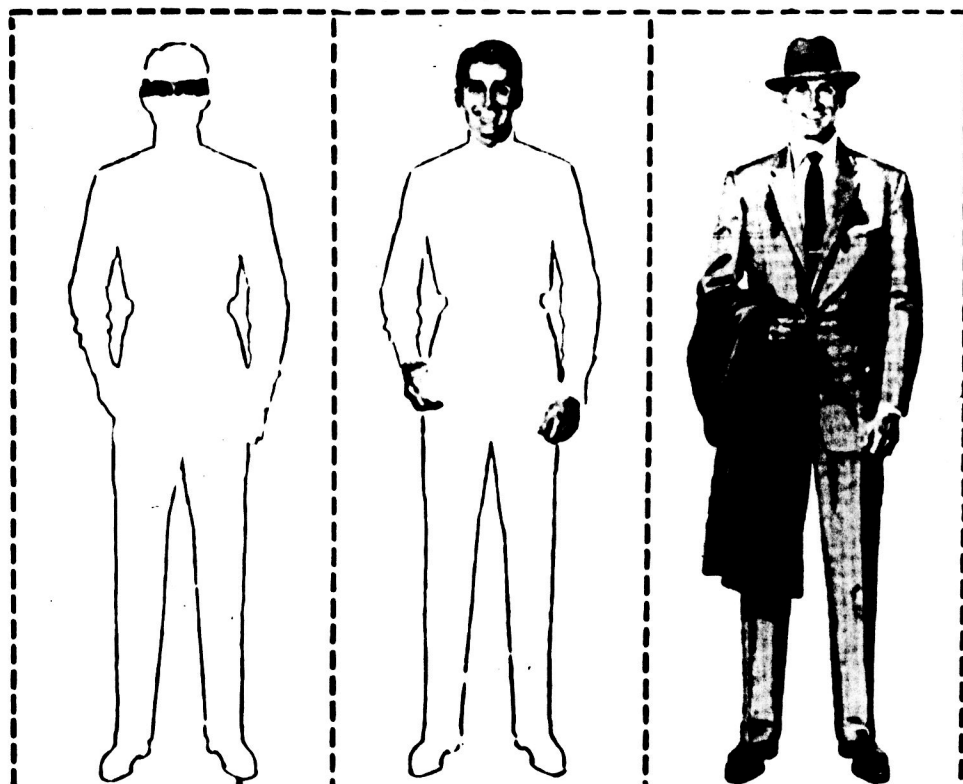

From the Infield Harrier Scoring

A cross country score is one of the things in sports.

Usually when a person hears a cross country score, he figures the high score should win. Two weeks ago, Michigan State scored only 16 points in a dual meet, while the Buckeyes tallied 47.

The general impression was that the Spartans had really been trounced. Actually, they were the ones that took the beating.

There is, unfortunately, no standard cross country score. The methods vary, and the sport is being conducted under the National AAU or Big Seven.

Michigan State scores all of its meet seven man ruling in which five men are with the two others counting against the team.

If the Spartan Harriers were to win a position in a meet they would receive 15 points by adding up the first five places. If Michigan State finished first, the Buckeyes, who State would automatically place.

In a dual meet the lowest possible score is 15 points, the highest possible 50 points.

In a dual meet, such as the NCAA, the first place team receives 15 points, the second place team 10 points, the third place team 7 points, the fourth place team 4 points, the fifth place team 2 points, and the sixth place team 1 point.

In the NCAA meet it is possible to place, but still take the 65th place. This is complicated. Yes. But so is the game of football.

At times, become further complicated, a system is not followed everywhere. In some cases, an eight man rule is used. The team scoring best three athletes in the other team. A perfect score is 15 points.

The Big Seven Conference also uses its own scoring system. Under this system, the team can count in the actual score, but not in the final score.

However, when a Big Seven team meets a team that conforms to the NCAA system, it must conform to the NCAA system.

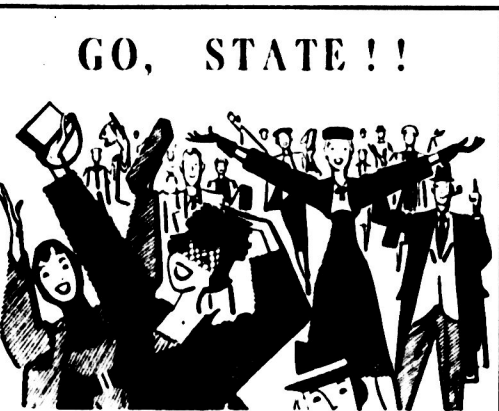
