Seeks U.S. Pool To End Invasion

MOSCOW (AP)—Soviet Russia served notice Monday night it is prepared to use force to bring about an end to British and French actions against Egypt.

Prime Minister Nikita Khrushchev said the Soviet Union was prepared to take the risk of a possible confrontation with the West, but would not be drawn into a general war.

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In New York, the Soviet Union pressed the Bulgarian demands before a special session of the UN Security Council. It demanded approval of a plan for U. S.-Russian military intervention in the Middle East unless the British, French and Israeli forces withdraw from Egypt within three days.

In Paris, Premier Guy Mollet announced an emergency meeting of the French cabinet.

The French cabinet met in a special session Monday night to discuss the Bulgarian demands.

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An Israeli column strikes westward through the Sinai Desert toward the Suez Canal. Israel announced the capture of virtually all of the Sinai Peninsula last week. Egyptian Pres. Gamal Abdel Nasser concentrated his forces west of the canal for promised 'total war'. Monday they announced a cease-fire in the area.

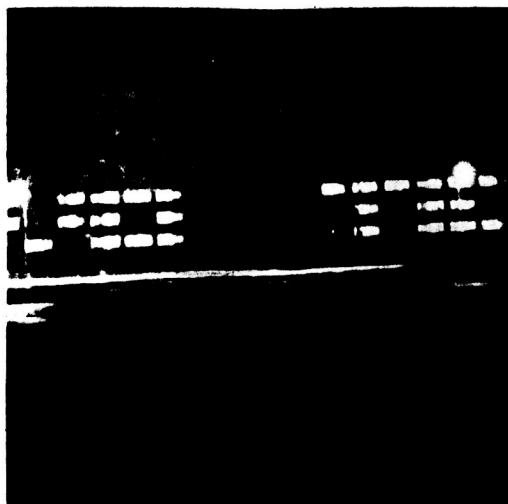

He said Americans "sincerely hope" the people of Hungary can accept the 50 million dollars worth of aid this country has offered. And he said this country remains committed to the free world.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 5.—Democratic and Republican campaigns for control of the new 80th Congress that will convene Jan. 3, are under way. The Democrats are seeking to win the House and the Republicans are seeking to win the Senate.

On the eve of the balloting, the Democrats were generally regarded as favorites to win the House, while the Republicans were favored to win the Senate.

Republicans, banking on an Eisenhower victory, were hopeful that they would carry a GOP Congress into office with him as he did in 1952.

In the present Congress, the Democrats hold a 49-17 margin over the Republicans in the Senate.

Heppinstall Starts 43rd Year at State

Now in his 43rd year at Michigan State, Head Trainer Jack Heppinstall has nursed the aches and bruises of probably more than 10,000 athletes, and has worked with 13 football coaches.

He came to MSU in 1914 and has been here longer than any other member of the present athletic staff.

A native of Jackson County, Ind., he came to the State in 1904. In 1905 he was named head coach of the football team and in 1906 he was named head coach of the basketball team.

At MSU his job has been seeing to the physical welfare of all athletic teams in the prevention and care of injuries. Up until 1918 he was also in charge of all athletic equipment.

Heppinstall has watched many changes come at MSU, and has seen many changes in the way things are done here.

He has more than any other school in the country. When I came here I was the third full time man under Coach Macklin, who was our head coach and athletic director. Now we have 11 full time men in the athletic department.

He now has four student assistants and two full time men, Fox, Dietrich and Gayle-Rouen. The total enrollment has also increased from around 1200-1400 students at that time to over 10,000.

It keeps on growing, just like a snowball. Heppinstall says, but the changes have been for the best.

Having lived in two countries and traveled a good deal, Heppinstall has seen many different schools in many different places, but says that for him there is just "one school" and "one country."
