

Buckeyes Drop Records

CHICAGO, Ill.—Ohio State leads in rebounding average and withstood determined challenges to its undefeated record. Ohio State's offensive load has held up with an average of 84 points per game to 76 Buckeyes' domination of all ten basketball statistics. Whereas until last week the Buckeyes continued to capitalize on sharpshooting, they were Conference leaders with a floor percentage of 51 and a free throw accuracy of 74%. They now rank at the 74.5 mark in offense and shot 50% averages. Indiana, which lengthened its lead over Ohio, dropped a one-pointer to Ohio State's Jerry Lucas as its defense has taken over the lead in total scoring with an average of 26.5 points to 25.5 for the opponents. Indiana is in field goals and in field goals resumed its early-season goal shooting averages.

INDIANAPOLIS—Three thousand students again go Michigan this Saturday. The state's 500 high schools are removed to districts competing this week.

Michigan's three most difficult teams capable of going all the way

The district winners will meet in the regionals next week. Only 32 teams, 8 in each class, remain after the regionals.

THE QUARTERFINALS further reduce the teams to four in each class. They are played March 21 on various neutral courts around the state.

THE CHAMPIONSHIPS will be held April 4-5 at the Michigan City Auditorium.

Jucker's prediction: Cincinnati finished the season with six straight victories and won the Missouri Valley title for





Tribunals Convicting Terrorists

MAVANA, IND.—A large crowd gathered by local leaders, foreign journalists Wednesday, was the government's answer to the mounting wave of terrorism, bombing and killing throughout Latin America.

Two convicted terrorists were executed Tuesday and five more early Wednesday as military tribunals stepped up the process of hundreds of rebels awaiting trial.

THE KNOWN total of foreign rebels executed since a new law established the death penalty for sabotage now stands at 15. Firing squads have cut down a total of 360反革命分子 in unofficial counts since the Cuban leader came to power two years ago.

Despite the still-penalizing of the new law, terrorists have day after day set off a bomb in the headquarters of the Cuban Popular Socialist Revolutionary party.

In the past week a bomb exploded in a private school and wounded nine persons. Five damaged a major warehouse belonging to the bank of foreign trade and its guard was killed. A bomb exploded in the Cuban three garage here. An explosion and fire destroyed an auto shop at the government-owned station, constructed from the floor down last year.

MILITARY tribunals at Havana, La. Cabana, and other places have sent 100 of Wednesday's death sentences. These other persons were given terms ranging from 15 to 30 years, including a woman, Lilia Perez Leon. She got 15 years.

Ambassador Harriman Visits Rome

Harriman said he had come to Italy with no particular negotiations in mind.

As this is of great interest to us. We discussed it particularly in Rome and it will come up again later this month in London.

The London meeting will bring together Western countries and Japan for a discussion of economic aid programs.
