



According to East Lansing merchants, the greatest demand has been for black and white turtlenecks. However, colors that coordinate with those found


The turtleneck sweater, which in sports coats and other clohas become increasingly popular thing are in high demand this

More man-made fibers will be used in all types of clothing. according to Bernetta Kahabka, Cooperative Extension Service textiles specialist at MSI

In the future we can expect even easier care and greater durability from the man-made fibers with us today and those to be developed.

Innovations by fiber manufacturers include a thermoreactive fiber that will adjust to temperature, a self-sterilizing fiber and improved techniques in texturizing varns

Development of an all-purpose solvent that would dryclean and launder in one operation is connected with antisoiling finishes already on the market

Since development and testing of any new clothing product cannot duplicate actual wear and care conditions." Miss Kahabka added. "consumers have the option to try the new developments when they are first marketed or to wait until most of the problems are worked

Styles cover a variety of old and new trends. Among thera are refined brass and gold ornaments, baby doll toes, higher heels. flower trim, miniboots and the Thirties influence.

Leathers inspiring this footwear include smooth, grained. waxy, embossed, suede, brushed. lustre and patent.

For daytime wear, shoes are set off with slings, straps or discreet trim. Sling-backs are abundant-one indication of a more feminine feeling in footwear. Straps continue wide and not too strippy, showing more leather. as in fat T-strap or maryjane styles.

Important exception to the lady like look is the hightongued. low-heeled pump sporting monk strap or brass studs. a style meant to accompany tailored costumes.

The classic moc is joined by the soft-look moccasin, in glove or brushed leathers with kilkie fringe or tassel treatment, tihy nailheads and pastel colers sometimes set off by white bind-

As part of the "Bonnie and Clyde" or Thirties influence on fashion, the spectator-tie appears in black-white or all white, and in smooth or lightly grained leathers paired with patent. Chunk mid-heels, perforated trim and soft ribbon ties complete the look.

TIPS FOR MEN

Loosen that tie! style is changing

NEW YORK (UPI) -- If you tie your tie too tightly it will wrinkle. If you tie it loosely you will be much more fashionable. If you wear your tie tack up high people will think you're wearing an elegant stickpin and it will hold the tie just as straight.

If your shirt gets all bunched up at the waist you can prevent it by doing the way the GIs do -- grasp both sides of the shirt body at the waist and make a deep turnback pleat in the extra cloth. Then tighten the belt.

If your brown leather shoes are too light you can darken them by rubbing with milk to which a few drops of household ammonia have been added. If you want to feel safer have a professional shoe dyer dye them for you.

If you leave suspenders attached to trousers when you hang them away on clamp hangers they will drag on the floor and get dirty if you don't loop them inside the trouser legs. If your closet floors are that dirty go over the floor with a cloth dampened in turpentine. This will keep out the

If you're still troubled by moths set a bowl of pipe tobacco in the closet. If that doesn't work get some moth balls. If you're troubled with silverfish, God forbid, wrap your stored-away woolen clothes in plain old newspapers. If you're wearing a light suit don't carry the newspaper under your arm--the ink might come off.

If you haven't put away your summer ties yet place them over the crossbar of a hanger, cover with paper and they'll be in better shape next Spring. If you spill soup on the ties while putting them away you can get the grease-stain out by rubbing on talcum powder and leaving overnight.

If you have balls of fuzz on the outside of a washable sweater, turn it wrongside out when you wash it and the pilling will end up on the inside where it won't show. If you're storing the sweaters put them in a box and don't hang them up or they'll loose their shape.

If the linings of your old shoes are badly worn they're probably too loose and you're wearing the wrong size. If the tips of the shoes show excessive wear they're too short. If you have trouble putting on shoe polish between the upper and the soles use a cotton-tipped stick.

If you want to look taller wear a hat with a tapered crown and narrow hatband. If you're checking your hat, see that the girl doesn't set another on top of it and get it greasy. If you are playing golf in the rain a plastic wrap hanging down bdhind will make the water run down the plastic instead of down your neck.

If you get lipstick stains on white shirts or handkerchiefs rub them with a little butter on wax paper then rub with dry absorbent cotton. If you do this a couple of times everything will wash out with soap and water. If you're using cleaning fluid dry the outer edge of the damp part vigorously with a


