Pheasants Fly Free!

There were at least 403 "new" pheasants enjoying the Spring weather last week in the Western Thumb, and members of Pigeon Conservation Club were hoping that every one of them is in a romantic, home-making mood.

The pheasants represented 80% of the 501 birds that were wintered over in the Club's big pen just west of town on Caseville Road. Club members construct-

ed the 1.4-acre pen last summer and provided feed, shelter and plenty of TLC for the birds. Cost of the pen, feed and care came to around \$11,000, club members said.

DNR officials, who provided the young pheasants last fall, said that an 80% survival rate through the winter is "extremely good."

About 25 members of the Pigeon Club cooperated with a DNR crew who came

here last week to capture the birds in the enclosure. The pheasants were leg-banded, crated and then released in 8 locations in the western Thumb.

Pheasants in the project included purebred Chinese Ringnecks—the breed that made the Thumb famous a half-century ago as a "pheasant hot-spot."

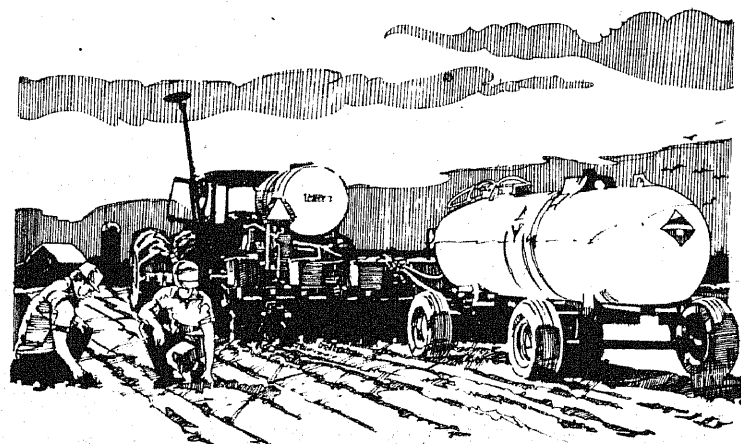

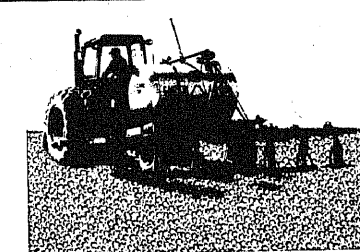
USA-FFA also had 4

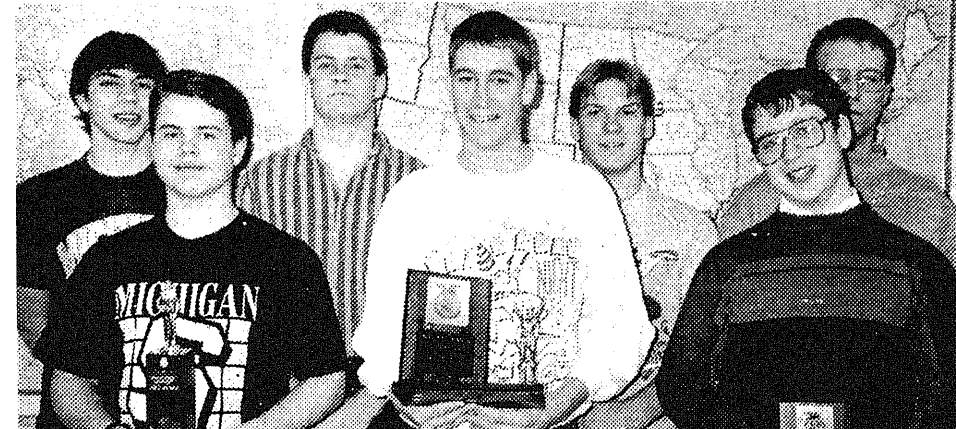

Others in the release were pure Sichuans, from eggs that were brought here from Sichuan Province in the Peoples Republic of China. Also included were crosses from the various strains.

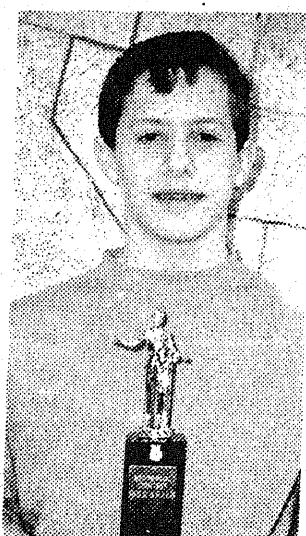
Sichuans are slightly smaller, more compact and darker-feathered—usually with no neckband of white or light feathers. Their value, it is believed, lies in the fact that they are brush

and wood dwellers, rather than the familiar open-field birds that are so well known here.

The pheasants were released at the start of the spring breeding season, so that they will be able to reproduce their numbers and turn around the declining pheasant populations. Club members' hopes are that pheasant hunting can be returned to the Thumb and other outstate areas of Michigan.



TWO BIRDS IN THE HAND: Wes Edington of Pigeon shows the proper form in handling the pheasants.



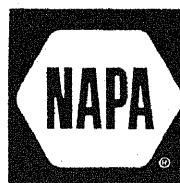

Why A Census?

It's part of the U.S. Constitution —
Article 1, Section 2 says...

"Representatives...shall be apportioned
among the several States...according to
their respective Numbers...The actual
Enumeration shall be made within three
years after the first meeting of the Congress
of the United States, and within every
subsequent Term of Ten years, in such
manner as (Congress) shall by Law direct."

How Important Are You?

Success of the census depends on you, on
everyone...

In 1990, questionnaires will be delivered
to more than 106 million housing units
and living quarters in the country. More
than 300,000 census takers and support
personnel will help conduct the census and
add up the final results.

How well you cooperate — this means
completing and returning your question-
naire — will determine how accurate the
census will be.

What's Ahead?

About a week before Census Day (April 1,
1990) most households will receive a ques-
tionnaire by mail. Others, depending on
location, will have forms delivered by
census takers.

Roughly five out of six households will
receive a short form. Nationally, about one
out of every six households will be asked to
fill out a longer form. In Huron County,
one in two residents will be asked to fill out
a longer form, because the data on Huron
County needs to be updated, according to
the federal government.

What's The Use Of A Census?

The population count for your area is used
to determine how many seats your state
will have in the U.S. House of Representa-
tives. States use the numbers to allocate
seats in their legislatures.

Billions of dollars in federal funds are
returned to states, local governments,
American Indian reservations and Alaska
Native villages. State funds are returned to
cities and counties. Amounts are based in
part on population or housing data. Be-
yond that, planners use census facts to
determine where to locate such facilities as
hospitals, schools, day care and senior
citizen centers. Various social programs
receive funds based on census information.
Businesses use the data for decisions in-
volving expansion and jobs.



QUESTIONS YOU MAY WANT TO ASK...

The Census Is Confidential!

So, why not stand up and count yourself
in the census? Neither a census taker nor
any other employee of the Census Bureau
can reveal information about you or your
household. Census personnel take an oath
to uphold this confidence. Failure to do so
can mean five years in prison and \$5,000
in fines. And what about other federal
agencies, can they get your census informa-
tion? The answer is NO!

Title 13 of the U.S. Code prevents any
agency - Immigration, the FBI, the IRS,
the courts, the military, welfare agencies -
from getting any specific information about
you. In fact, personal information from the
1990 Census will be locked up until the
year 2062.

Once the Census Bureau receives your
questionnaire, a key part of our work be-
gins. If the questionnaire is incomplete, a
census-employee must contact you to obtain
the information. The answers on your

questionnaire are combined with those
from other questionnaires to produce statis-
tical totals for various geographic areas. It
is these combined number, not your per-
sonal answers, that are published and pu-
to thousands of uses.

What's Will The 1990 Census Tell Us?

- How the nation is changing
- The condition of housing
- Education, employment and income
information about your area.
- The census takes the social and economic
pulse of the nation.

If You're Not Counted

For a number of reasons, about 2.2 mil-
lion people were not counted in the last
census (about 1 percent.) This is a called an
undercount. Among minority populations
the percentage was higher - about 6 per-
cent.

Unfortunately, undercount can result in
flawed decisions. Inaccurate counts can
curtail projects and cause lower funding
for community programs and services.
Often, those who could benefit most are
those who are shortchanged when there's
an undercount.
