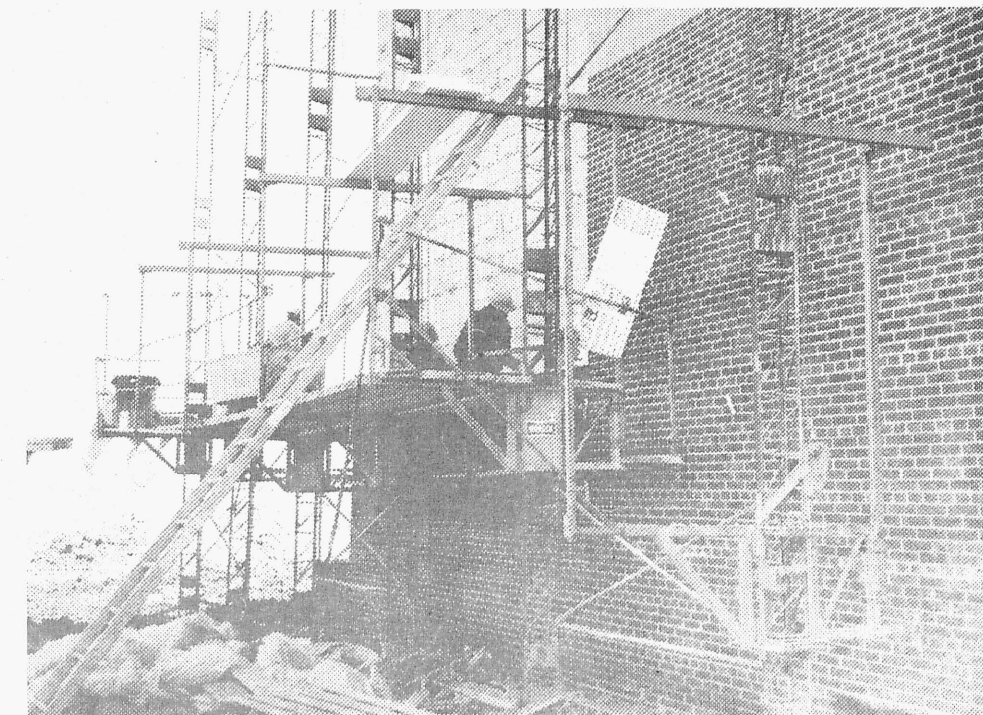

## Caseville raises special fee rates

By AMY HEIDEN

Caseville Village Council last week raised fees for rezoning, variance, special use or site plan reviews, bringing those fees more in line with Caseville Township fees.

Residents who need a variance to add to the property, or who want to rezone will have to pay a \$300 fee, according to Village Controller Pam Stahl.

That increased fee will cover administrative costs such as publication of notices pertaining to the request, as well as postage to notify property owners within 300 ft. of the property. The fee will also cover the costs of meetings held to discuss the requests.

Council also agreed to waive \$150 in sewer and water charges from Sharon Zollner's property. The small building at the corner of Main Street and Emerich Drive has no water facilities and no sewer hookup.

Zollner's land contract for the building states that the structure can't be torn down, but village ordinances say that unless they are demolished, all property owners will be charged for water and sewer. Village officials made an exception in her case, Stahl said, because of the circumstances.

In other business, Caseville Council:

■ Set a public hearing for May 9 at 7 p.m. to amend the village ordinance about recycling rates. The amendment would give Village Manager Gary Kuckel the authority to adjust recycling rates for commercial businesses, based on the amount of material it is recycling.

■ Accepted the resignation of Jan Prill from the ad-hoc recreation committee. The position won't be filled, Stahl said, because the committee is to be made up of two village residents and two township residents.

Five people were on the committee prior to Prill's resignation.

■ Set April 23 as Volunteer Day. Residents are invited to help plant trees in the village park at 9:30 a.m.

■ Agreed to purchase an FM radio system from Thumb Radio, Inc., Bad Axe, at a cost of \$2,075. The system will replace a CB radio system now in use that experiences a lot of interference.

■ Accepted a bid from Thumb Petroleum of Elkton for fuel. The village will pay

6.5 cents above wholesale for unleaded gasoline, and 9.5

cents above wholesale on diesel fuel.
