



Coach Roger Remar will field a team including eight seniors and seven juniors, of which three are returning starters from last year's 18-16 squad.





Veteran USA boys basketball coach John Manninen expects to have a "wait and see" outlook when it comes to predicting how his team's 1995-96 basketball season will pan out.

"I think we will be "spurty" until we gain experience and confidence," Manninen says.







The Caseville Eagles are hoping to improve last year's 3-18 record, as three starters from last year's


First-year coach Keith Hatfield will be counting on returning seniors Mark Prill, Nick Bednorek and junior Aaron Britt for leadership on the team. Those


Seniors Nate Gotts and Zac King also saw considerable action last year. Both will be playing guard this year, according to Coach Bill McLellan.

McLellan said, but the players are all capable of a


solid defense and rebounding. If there are any weaknesses, it might be that perimeter scoring could improve for the offense to be consistent.
