Mr. Wyden offered the following resolution:

Resolved, That the printed report be adopted by the first Board on adoption of the same for the government of the Board.

The resolution was adopted.

Mr. Krapi moved that a committee be appointed by the chairman to confer with the newspaper publishers of the county as to the lowest terms for publishing in full the proceedings of the board. Agreed to, and the chairman appointed Supervisors Krapi, Fugate, and Kinsinger, and Messrs. Kinsinger, Tracy and Thatcher as a committee.

Mr. Wagnon moved that the O. C. be authorized to instruct the assessor to appraise on the basis of the aggregate value of the property to be taxed, and to be sized and valuation.

Mr. Thielner moved, as an amendment, to qualify on the basis of the value of the property in millions of dollars. The amendment was accepted, and the motion was so amended was then adopted.

On motion of Mr. Feely the Board adjourned until to-morrow morning at half past 9 o'clock.

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
