Fossil Mine

The state of Wyoming is geological wonderland, and the most interesting is the newest land on the continent. There are very rich fossil deposits in the state; the remains varying in size from little invertebrates to large mammals. A fossil quarry has been established in a fossil quarry, situated in the extreme southwestern part of Wyoming, near the town of Kemmerer, in the summer of 1900. The fossil formation is known as the "Green River Terrier." The shale here is laminated and carboniferous and some streaks are bituminous, carbonaceous and oil in large quantities.

The quarry is worked exclusively by hand and there are no blasting operations. The shale is split into slabs and broken into pieces and then carried over the bank by hand. From the top of the quarry to the "floor," a few feet below, the shale contains fossils. When the slabs containing the specimens are taken apart, they are dried out to about a third of their original weight before the cleaning process begins. It is difficult to clean the fossils when the shale is too dry, but when it is wet, it is easy to remove the stones. Knives and saws made especially for the purpose are used.
