AUTO PLATES NOW COME FROM PRISON

State Making Auto Plates With Up-to-Date Machinery—Expect Cost to Be Lower.

At the Jackson state prison the 1921 auto license plates are now being manufactured by the thousands in a new plant recently installed and in addition new work is being planned for the immense presses.

Four machines are required for the operation. One cuts the outline of each plate from large sheets of steel. The next machine stamps out the four holes and four slots. Then a press embosses the figures from dies which are necessarily changed for each set of plates by the operator, an assistant arranging them in pairs and checking the rotation. Still another press stamps the state characters.

The machines exert a pressure of 70 tons upon the sheet metal.

A safety device is provided to make it impossible for the men to have their hands mangled while working. This device consists of two levers which must be operated at the same time in order to bring pressure upon the metal. This requires the use of both hands at a safe distance while the pressure is exerted.

After coming from the last press the plates are given an anti-rust bath, and afterward dipped in the background color and carried by endless chain to a huge oven where they are baked in a temperature of 235 degrees for two hours and 40 minutes.


