

For the unknown star pattere, make a block 10 inches aguare, using diamond units 1 inch wide and 2½ inches long, a square 1% inches long and irregular triangles to complete the circle. Four corner pieces aquare off the block.

And Make It Stordy When all the blocks for the quilt are complete, join them together. Add the border after the blocks are set. The quilt may be set in an silover pattern or in alternate patterned or plain blocks or in patternet blocks sinced with bands of

the quilt, and it is cut the same size. This may be dyed in a con-tracting color so that the reverse side of the quilt has a lovely effect. Lay the lining flat and smooth, then place the cotton batting which you use for the lining over that and finally the quilt. Pln and bast to-gether securely so there can be no gether securely so there can be no slipping during the quilting.

The quilting itself may be done on a frame, quilting hoop or with the quilt laid on a bed or table. There are two ways in which the actual quilting may be done. One is by shoving the needle straight up and then straight down, drawing it completely through the quilt with each stitch. Another way is to use a run-







