





Safety Precantions Listed

Electric fences take their toll of human lives every year. Most vicinitias are children. Also, many animals are killed. Listed below are some of the safety rules recommended by the National Safety council.

Do not use home-made electric fence controllers; they are not safe. No fence should be energined from any electric source encept through an approved controller, one that meets the safety standards of a recognized agency. It is important that the controller is properly installed with good ground and lightning protection.

Do not tamper with the controller lies. If it needs servicing return it to the manufacturer or have repairs to the controller in th

Teach children not to tamper er play with an electric fence.
Avoid locating an electric fence where the charged wire and a good ground such as a pipe line, pump, sinck tank, pand, irrigation ditch, er ether normally wet ground ean be contacted at the same time.
