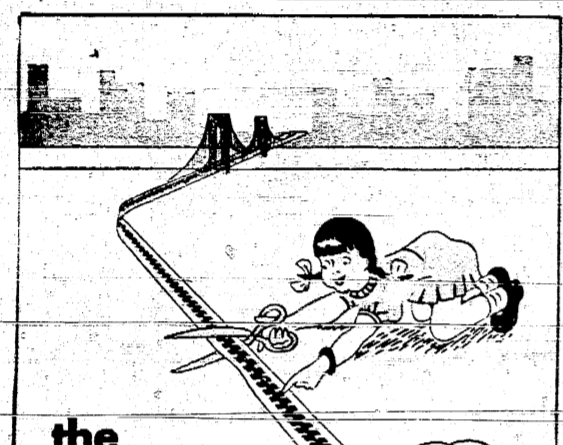

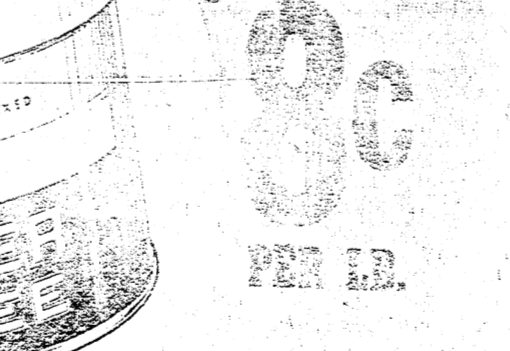

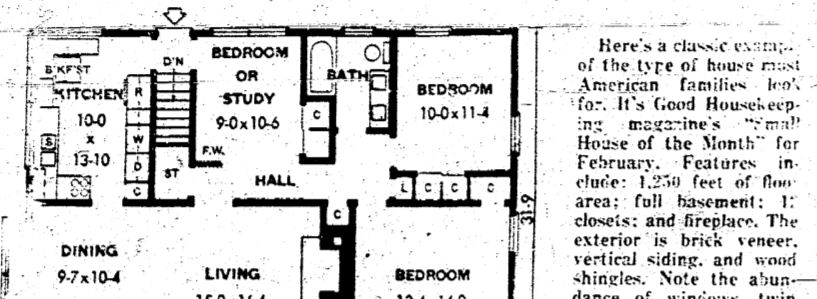

Tasty Orange-Mint Jelly

One of the most piquant favor combinations we know of is made by combining orange and mint. It's a family favorite. It's easy to make by following the test recipe.

Orange Marmalade
 3 1/2 cups sugar
 2 1/2 cups orange juice
 1 1/2 cups orange peel
 1 1/2 cups water

To prepare the fruit, cut 2 med. sized oranges from 6 medium-sized oranges. Add juice to fruit and let stand 10 minutes. Press juice through small cloth. Measure to a bowl and simmer, covered, 20 minutes. Cover 4 minutes. Measure 3/4 cup sugar. (This sugar is in addition to the 2 1/2 cups specified.) Place over high heat and boil, stirring constantly. Add remaining 1 1/2 cups sugar and set aside. Place saucan stir in bottled fruit pectin. Then holding fruit over high heat. Add hard 1 minute, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and stir. Add orange stir in sugar. Bring to a full rolling boil and boil hard 1 minute. Strain into glasses. Paraffin at once. Makes 12 one-cup glasses.

determine whether they are well founded.

So I say, if the spirit moves you, write your congressman. Write a letter which contains serious thought on the subject which has aroused your concern. Let me have your gripes, and even if your gripes involve my conduct or my own conduct, I still invite your comments and your criticism.

When you do write me, however, please do not expect me to reply with a long, detailed discussion of my views or position on the matter involved, particularly on matters of pending legislation.

I do not mean to say that I have any hesitancy about expressing my views on any subject on which I have obtained sufficient information to reach what I regard as an intelligent conclusion.

However, it will be my general policy to reserve final judgment on all matters of legislation until the bills involved have been presented to the House of Representatives, after study by the appropriate Committee, so that the facts pertaining to all sides of the question are available.

Even after proposed legislation is on the floor of the House, the debate on the floor and the amendments introduced there may alter the pending measure and open up entirely new avenues of thought and study.

Consider the position I would be in if I pledged myself to the support of a bill as introduced by a Member of the House, and then—in the committee or on the floor of the House—it was so amended and modified as to accomplish the opposite purpose from that stated in the bill, as originally introduced.

I could then be accused, if I failed to vote for that measure, of having broken faith with the constituents to whom I had undertaken my position in favor of the bill, as originally introduced, which I had not been identified by number only.

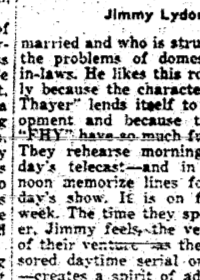

Simmons Points to Decline in Dairy Farming

Could Place Detroit Milk Supply in Jeopardy

Despite a marked upward trend in the price paid to farmers for milk in the Detroit producing area during the winter months, production continues to fall behind last year and milk shippers are dropping from the market in increasing numbers.

F.O.B. Detroit, for Class 1 of milk used for bottling, the price is arrived at by adding a premium of \$1.25 per hundredweight to the average price paid by 13 midwest condenseries, which according to Howard F. Simmons, secretary-manager of the Michigan Milk Producers Association, is steadily increasing.

The Detroit market having taken 8 per cent more milk for fluid purposes this year in January than a year ago.

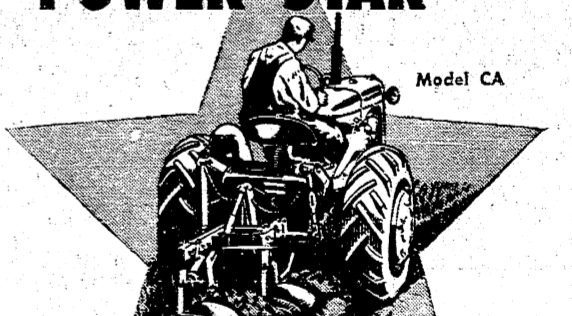

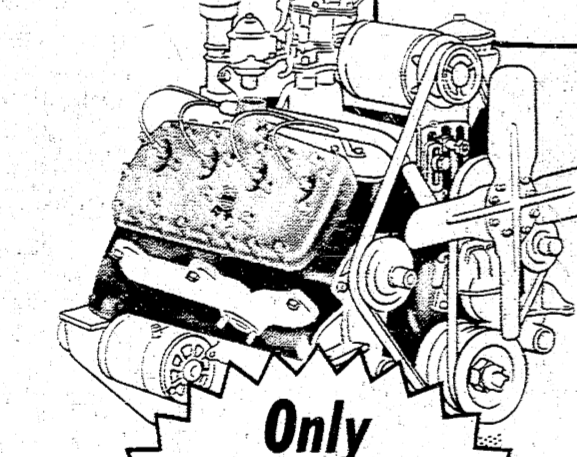
