

Sun Rays Run Motor



Scientists point out that enough sunshine drenches the roof of an average one-family dwelling in 30 minutes to light, heat and run the electrical appliances in that dwelling for an entire year. But as yet engineers and scientists haven't learned the secret of converting the sun's rays efficiently into energy for such household chores.

If a candle isn't available, the Sun Motor can be propelled by the beam of the 150-watt electric lamp (lower right) focused on a series of so-called photoroltine colls (upper right). Energy from the light beam or ordinary sanitant is converted themically into electrical carries by the cells and the electrical current spins the flywheel. Although an extremely inefficient power converter, the Sun Motor demonstrates the principle that sanlight is power.
