Since coughing is a result of irritation of the throat or bronchial passages, it has as many different causes as there are different irritants. A dust, for instance, or hot dry air and of course, asthma, lung or chest illness, disorders of the nerves involved in the cough reflex, or ear-ners can all cause coughing. Coughing can even be a matter of a reflex action.

Drugs that will suppress coughing by hitting at the cough reflex, the object of intensive laboratory research. Codeine used to be the main cough-suppressant but it is being replaced by other drugs because of its narcotic nature and as well as undesirable side-effects.

Researchers in recent years have discovered large numbers of chemical compounds to find non-narcotic anti-cough drugs. Early on there was an effective and safe drug called Codeine which was used to suppress coughing. Codeine was discovered to act satisfactorily and without the danger of addiction and that it seemed no drawback or complication.
