

It all started when Mrs. Schaffer read the requisites for a cub sout merit badge and found the boys were to visit something historic. At the township library, Miss Jane Palmer librarian was consulted. With Memorial Day in the offing, she made the suggestion that the group make a study of the monument which stands "a grim reminder of those who gave their lives in the cause of Freedom."

The Washtenaw County Atlas of 1874 tells a little about the monument as follows, "Citizens of Sharon erected a beautiful memorial monument. It was raised by voluntary and general subscription and commemorates the names of President Lincoln and 24 volunteers from Sharon—martyrs to the imperishable cause of Freedom."






